#### **Letter from the Chair:**

The end of summer has been a busy time for your TCDP central committee!

On August 15th we hosted a fabulous Midsummer Party for the Party at Dresser Mansion. Over 100 folks attended to hear mayoral candidate Monroe Nichols, state Chairwoman Aleicia Andrews, Sen. Jo Anna Dossett, and Rep. Amanda Swope set the pace for Campaign 2024. The Party for the Party was a kickoff of more such receptions across the county this fall and winter.



Senator Dossett also spoke at our August monthly meeting. Jo Anna is a hard-working senator both for Tulsa and all of Oklahoma. She works well with others and reaches across the aisle to make senate bills better She is up for reelection in 2024 and we are going to work hard to retain this district for Democrats.

In more action, your county officers attended the annual state AFL-CIO Labor Day Parade in Henryetta. This is a great event and the largest such pro-labor in the U.S. Afterwards, we were treated with the Okmulgee County Democratic Party Barbecue at the city's community center and town hall.

Just yesterday, your county party hosted the kickoff of the Bus Road Trip to Victory at the historic Vernon African Methodist Episcopal (AME) Church on Greenwood. We enjoyed a fantastic breakfast and wished the state party well on its way to circumvent Oklahoma in an effort to win back rural Oklahoma voters. Democrats stand with rural Oklahoma in saving its schools, hospitals, and other community institutions, and furthering rural development. A big shout-out to Briana Shea who put this all together!

Vernon AME Church was the perfect venue for this kickoff. The church is named for an AME Bishop, William Tecumseh Vernon, who was president of the HBUC Western University in Kansas City and the first African American Register of the U.S. Treasury during both the Theodore Roosevelt and Taft administrations. During the 1921 Tulsa Race Massacre refugees were urged to "run to Vernon" to escape the rampaging mobs.

Our September monthly meeting will be held this Tuesday, September 26th, and will feature Rep. Melissa Provenzano. Mellissa is a teacher and will have a lot to say about the TPS struggles with State Supt. Ryan Walters.
